Board Meeting Highlights

- Six requests to the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) were approved by the board.
- The ARC continues to refine requirements for fencing and gutter colors.
- The printed directory for 2023 has been delivered.
- The Common Properties Committee (CPC) is doing an inventory of tree stumps that might be ground down if funds are available.
- The CPC will be asking for bids from other firms for miscellaneous jobs during the year to get a better feel for other contractors. The board approved giving all interested contractors copies of a blank CDPOA Common Properties Service Contract so bids can be more evenly compared.
- The Social Committee has set the date for the Spring Social for April 18th. Tickets are \$25 each. **Reservations are due no later than April 10** and checks must be made out to CDPOA.
- The number of subscribers for the Vyve Community Cable TV package is down substantially. The Community Cable TV Coordinator has begun discussions with Vyve to minimize the impact on the fees because of the reduced number of subscribers.
- The board voted to accept the offer from Lindley Pettigrew & Company CPAs LLC to provide accounting and bookkeeping services for \$100 per month after fees of \$600 for Federal tax return and \$75 if SC tax returns are required.
