### Feral cats in our neighborhood

Your CDPOA Board of Directors has been advised that the feral cat population in our neighborhood is increasing because POA members are feeding them. This is causing genuine concern. The feeding of feral cats by putting their food out of doors makes them want to stay in our midst to get fed. The food then attracts other less desirables, like coyotes, raccoons, stray dogs, etc. Also, the feral cats kill local birds. The City of Clemson is a designated bird sanctuary within its boundaries, and as such, we, as city residents, should do our part to protect the bird population around us. So please, DO NOT feed feral, undomesticated cats. Thank you.
